Cultural Activity Training

- **Jesus Pastor**, an internationally recognized Latino culture educator provided a four-hour training for 14 volunteers, parent facilitators and childcare providers on cultural activities related to our Popular Education methodology and philosophy on Saturday November 13th.

Curriculum Development

- The facilitators adapted workshop four – *Understanding Report Cards*.
- The parent facilitators have been working all summer-fall with three master teachers developing three of our seven new units to support “meaningful” parent involvement and parent-teacher collaborations.

Outreach

- Beginning 10/21/10, our parent facilitators called 480 Latino parents and mailed information about **McKay Saturday Language Academy** classes for ELL students to explain the program and encouraged parents to send their children. Now, each week before the classes, five of our parent facilitators call 480 parents over three hours.
- **Outcome:** There was a significant increase in the number of students attending the classes. From 10 Latino ELL students to between 70-80 students since our parent facilitators are doing the outreach.
- Called and mailed information about the **School Board Budget Listening Sessions** at North and McKay High Schools to encourage parent participation.
- **Outcome:** Over 120 Spanish speaking parents attended the listening sessions.

Our Oregon Parent Education Center has now a Parent Coordinator and is open from Monday to Friday from 10am to 5pm to support parents on strategies to modify behavior, college applications, gang prevention support groups and all the services of Mano a Mano Family Center and the Latinos Unidos’ (LUS) At-risk Youth Dropping Center
