- From July 1, 2010-March 31, 2010, SKCE offered 39 *Educate and Inspire* workshops in 11 low-income Salem-Keizer schools for 837 adults and 38 youth (875 total participants).
- SKCE provided age-appropriate, educational childcare for 866 children.
- Workshop participants and children received hot, home cooked meals.

**9<sup>th</sup> Annual Heart of Literacy Parenting Conference**

- SKCE staff co-coordinated the conference with SKSD and Marion County staff.
- SKCE called parents and sent flyers announcing the event.
- SKCE facilitators presented four workshops and staffed an information table.
- Unusually cold weather impacted some families ability to attend the conference.

### ***Making Parenting a Pleasure Workshops***

Two POP facilitators attended the *Making Parenting a Pleasure* Spanish facilitator training in July and August in partnership with Catholic Community Services. These workshops are for parents of young children and provide information on child development and effective parenting. This fall, 15 parents attended the 13-workshop series. A new series of workshops began on January 19, 2011. 12 parents are attending the workshops.

### **McKay Saturday Language Academy Outreach and Workshops**

The new session for students began January 22<sup>nd</sup> and ended March 5<sup>th</sup>. Five SKCE facilitators called 500+ parents every Thursday before the Academy to advertise the opportunity for youth. Over 80 students attended each week. SKCE continues partnering with McKay to provide outreach and workshops for parents. Parents attending the last series of workshops received certificates at a small celebration.

### **Gang Prevention Support Groups**

- Since June, SKCE has had 15, 2-hour, gang prevention support groups at the Oregon Parent Education Center on Saturdays.
- The support groups have different themes and are informally based on the 40 Developmental Assets
- The sessions are facilitated in Spanish by community members. Childcare is provided. Average attendance is 10 people.
